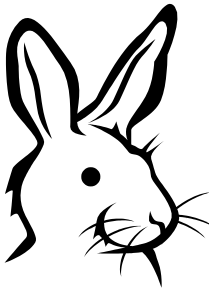
Birds migrate in winter to get food all year.



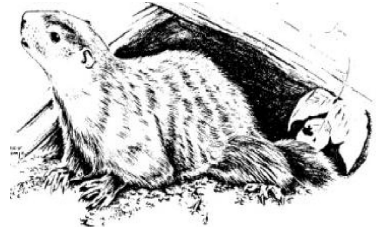
Thick fur on a polar bear to keep it warm.

Woodchucks hibernate through a long winter.



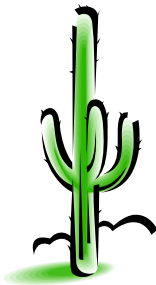
Opossums “play dead” to confuse predators.
